Students completing this certificate will develop a basic understanding of the airline industry and the customer safety, security, and service requirements necessary to work as a flight attendant for a major airline.

To earn a certificate, complete the required courses as listed with a minimum grade of "C." At least 50% of all coursework must be completed at Cypress College. The Basic certificate offers students a career ladder from which they may experience incremental success as they progress to an Advanced Certificate or an Associate in Science Degree.
