To earn a certificate, students must complete the required courses as listed with a minimum grade of "C." At least 50% of all coursework must be completed at Cypress College.

ACR Technician Associate Science Degree
Combine **ACR 1 & ACR 2 Certificates** with the local **General Education** graduation requirements.

ACR Advanced Technician Associate Science Degree
Combine **ACR 3 & ACR 4 Certificates** with the local **General Education** graduation requirements.

To earn an Associate's Degree, students must complete:

- (1) all major course requirements with a "C" or better;
- (2) 25 units of General Education requirements;
- (3) the cultural diversity and reading requirements;
- (4) any elective courses to complete a minimum of 60 units; and
- (5) have a minimum GPA of 2.0. At least 50% of all major course work must be completed at Cypress College.
