

## Administration of Justice

#### GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The Administration of Justice major examines the structure, functions, laws and procedures, and decision-making processes of agencies that deal with crime management, such as police, procedures, courts, and correctional facilities. This curriculum offers students the opportunity to learn skills necessary for working with local, state, or federal law enforcement agencies. Students will be transfer ready and prepared for entry-level but dedicated work in the field.

#### **DEGREE**

#### **AS-T Administration of Justice**

To earn an AS-T in Administration of Justice: Students must complete the following requirements: (1) a minimum of 18 semester units with a minimum grade of \*C"; (2) the California State University Education General Breadth requirements (CSU-GE Breadth) or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) for a minimum of 39 units; (3) completion of 60 semester units; (4) and have a minimum overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0.

### **CERTIFICATES**

#### **Homeland Transportation Security**

To earn a certificate, complete the required courses as listed with a minimum grade of "C." At least 50% of all course work must be completed at Cypress College. The Basic Certificate offers students a career ladder from which they may experience incremental success as they progress to an advanced certificate and/or Associate in Science Degrees.
